"DLD Together" is a course for families of children and young people with DLD. It was developed in collaboration with NAPLIC. We are aware that families want to know more about DLD and are finding it hard to access information. We believe that well informed and well supported families are essential if children and young people with DLD are to reach their full potential.

Course details

- 7 weekly sessions lasting 60-90 minutes
- Can be delivered via Zoom/Teams, or in person
- There is no cost to parents to attend the course
- Course participants will be offered ongoing support from Afasic

Every family of a child or young person with Developmental Language Disorder needs to understand the condition, its impact on their child and what they can do to help them. By knowing more and connecting with other families they will be able to support their child better. Our ambition is that over time they become a large influential voice.

An estimated 1 million children and young people in the UK have DLD. Our long-term aim is that it is standard practice across the UK for services to offer this training as part of their DLD pathway. The course is already well established in many areas, including Birmingham, Devon, Edinburgh, Newcastle and Sheffield, as well as several London Boroughs.

Training for professionals

- FREE one-day online training session, provided by NAPLIC and Afasic.
- Open to any UK professionals.

You need to be working in an area where DLD diagnosis is happening regularly and be committed to run two groups per year. Colleagues are encouraged to attend together.

We often receive enquiries from family members who would like to attend the course and we run national courses for these families - but we do rely on trained professionals to volunteer to run these for us.
